

General Guidelines

1. The Competition shall be open for the students currently pursuing their Bachelor's Degree in law i.e., 3-Year LL.B. course or 5-Year LL.B. or Master of Laws i.e. LL.M. course from any recognized university/school in India.
2. Individual participation as well as participation in a team of two i.e., co-authorship is allowed.
3. The format of the Award shall be in the following chronological order. Please peruse the Arbitral Award Draft for reference.
 - a. Cover Page: The cover page must include the name of the competition, name of the parties, and the name of the student author(s).
 - b. Statement of Facts
 - c. Issues in Dispute
 - d. Arguments from the Claimant and the Respondent
 - e. Decision and Award
4. The Award must be submitted in both Microsoft Word and PDF format.
5. The Entry must be typewritten. Font: Times New Roman, font size 12, line spacing 1.5 and justified alignment; proper page numbering should be inserted.
6. Margins: 1 inch on all sides.
7. The manuscript should be accompanied by a cover letter specifying the author's name, designation, institute, contact number, and e-mail for future reference.
8. The Bluebook, A Uniform System of Citation (**21st Ed.**) is to be followed. All footnotes must be in Times New Roman, size 10, single-spacing, and justified.
9. There is no registration fee for the competition but the participants are required to fill out the **final submission** form (which will act as the registration form as well).

Submission Guidelines

1. The participants should note that no fee will be charged, either for registering or submitting the final awards.
2. The participants do not have to fill out any separate registration form for registering in the competition. The submission form attached in the below point will serve as bonafide registration of the candidate.
3. The participants have to submit their Awards on or before **20th October 2024** by filling out the registration and submission form [here](#).
