RGNUL observes RTI Week (6thOct-12thOct 2021)

National Workshop on “Right to Information: A Revolutionary Law” was organised by Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab in collaboration with Punjab State Information Commission (PSIC) in observance of RTI Week (6thOct-12thOct 2021). Sh. Suresh Arora, former DGP Punjab and Chief Information Commissioner, Punjab State Information Commission, was Chief Guest for the inaugural session of the week-long workshop. Hailing RTI as “Sunshine Act”, Mr. Arora spoke about changes ushered by the enactment of Right to Information. Dr. Sridhar Acharyulu, Dean MU-SOL, former member CIC, referred to RTI as a landmark judgement in his address.

Prof G.S. Bajpai, Vice-Chancellor, RGNUL highlighted on significant changes heralded by the Act while welcoming the guests and delegates.
