This apart, B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) Degree with specialisation in International Law has been reintroduced from Academic Session 2024-25. RGNUL has also introduced new subjects like Agricultural Laws, Laws on National Security, Counter Insurgency, and Defense Strategies, Energy Laws, Information Security and Data Protection Laws, Infrastructural Law etc. in its scheme of study.

RGNUL has also taken a lead in integrating Indic Knowledge System into its legal education framework. This includes the introduction of Ancient Jurisprudence, Shaastric Methods of Inquiring into the Truth and Shaastric Methods of Argumentation etc.

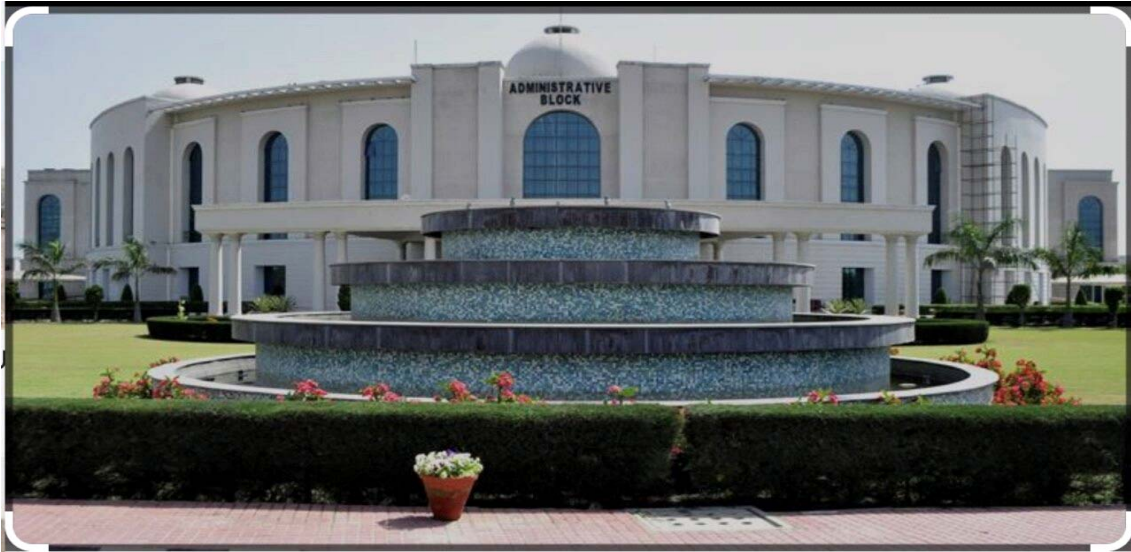

2 MILITANTS KILLED IN KUPWARA DIST

Srinagar: Two militants were killed in an ambush attack in Kupwara district on Thursday. The militants were engaged in a gunfight with security forces near the town of Doda. The attack took place at a school where the militants, who had been hiding during search operations in the area, were spending the night. It was a targeted ambush attack in the forest area of Doda near the one on Monday night in the Kula Dera forest, during which four soldiers, including a captain, were killed. On Wednesday night also, militants engaged in a brief exchange of fire with security forces in the Kupwara district. Thursday's attack was reported by the Government High School in Doda, around 2 am. The troops had arrived there to search for militants earlier, and were set to resume the search operations at dawn. After the militants opened fire, the troops retreated and the exchange of fire continued till dawn, after which the militants fled from the forest. The two soldiers were injured and one of them, who was a serious

THE FIRST-TIME Congress MP from Tamil Nadu's Mayiladuthurai constituency, R Sudha, says she was taught the importance of education at a young age.

Sudha, 46, hails from Guimptipondy village in Thiruvallur district, where girls being married off at 13 or 16 years was a common practice. "Good education that my mother could afford for me when my father died of cardiac arrest at a young age. I thought of how my education could help peo-

ple," she says. She chose to become a lawyer, going on to file two PILs which made an impact on public life.

In 2021, at the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic, Sudha approached the Madras High Court to seek the release of day train for the benefit of school children who depended on school meals each day, she says.

Sudha's journey in the same year, she moved the high court to seek the restoration of sanitary napkins vending machines in schools for girl students. The court directed some schools to install the machines, she says.
