**‘Developing MOOCs: Requirements, Strategies and Limitations’
One-Day Training Programme**

The department of Sociology, RGNUL conducted One-day Training Programme on ‘Developing MOOCs: Requirements, Strategies and Limitations’ for the faculty members of RGNUL. The inaugural session of the Training Programme was chaired by Prof. Naresh Vats, Registrar, RGNUL, Punjab. The inaugural session was followed by two business sessions.

The first business session was about training the participants regarding various technical and academic aspects of developing Massive Online Open Courses (MOOCs). Mr. Tejinder Singh, Producer, Electronic Multi-Media Research Centre (EMRC), Punjabi University, Patiala was resource person for the first session. He focused on the role of ‘On-Camera presentation’ while recording lectures for the MOOCs. He emphasized on the role of voice modulation, role of gestures and importance of body language during online lectures. “Discussion series, lecture series, mootings and other relevant issues can be considered for designing of videos for EMRC,” he said. He also discussed the opportunity provided to teachers through the Direct to Home (DTH) Programmes. He apprised the faculty that different themes of law and human rights were currently being designed in EMRC, Punjabi University, Patiala.

Mr. Chandan Dravid, Producer, Electronic Multi-Media Research Centre (EMRC), Punjabi University, Patiala was resource person for the second business session. He dwelt on the importance of quality e-content. He also emphasized on technicalities related to editing of video. He elaborated on the role of background music, pictures, graphics, bytes, animations in the videos. These technical issues were demonstrated with videos presenting different stages of editing. Mr. Dravid said, “Teachers must be well rehearsed with the script/ e-content before recording of the video lectures.” The valedictory session was addressed by Prof. Anand Pawar, Dean Student Welfare and Controller of Examinations, RGNUL, Punjab.
