It examined judicial responses to disability, including activism, legislative reforms, learning disability assessment, workplace inclusivity, and implementation gaps. These sessions aimed to foster interdisciplinary dialogue, promote inclusive policies, and advance disability rights and social justice, striving for a more equitable society.

The valedictory ceremony was then concluded by Ms. Mansi Madan, Assistant Professor, DME Law School and Faculty Co-Convenor, International Conference and Ms. Srilakshmi Karampudi, Student Convenor, International Conference.
